


Committee, headed by Eksath Perera, fashioned a **Historic event!**

Drawing on his own conversion from Buddhism to Christianity and the experiences of life lived in the U.K., Sri Lanka and Australia, Kanishka spoke an inclusive and gentle message. A message of **joy** – in the face of despair: of **light** – in the midst of darkness.

Godelieve's organ artistry was stupendous! She lifted the choir to heights celestial! She is a gentle soul; humble, cheerful and utterly selfless in
