Note from the Treasurer

Please note ruling about last minute non-attendance at our Dances and Have-a-Chat parties.

RULE: Non-attendance at Events after Tickets have been sold

1. If a member or guest having booked a place at an event and cannot attend due to unforeseen circumstances and does not notify the Club organiser, or cancels their attendance, **less than 48 hours before the function date**, the member or guest, must pay the full price of the Entrance fee (ticket fee).
2. If a member or guest having booked a place at an event and cannot attend and informs the Club event organiser atleast **48 hours before the Function date**, the Club will refund the Entrance fee (Ticket fee) less the cost of the food as per the Caterer's charge.

I would also like to thank all the members who attended the Annual General Meeting and provided their support to elect a new committee.



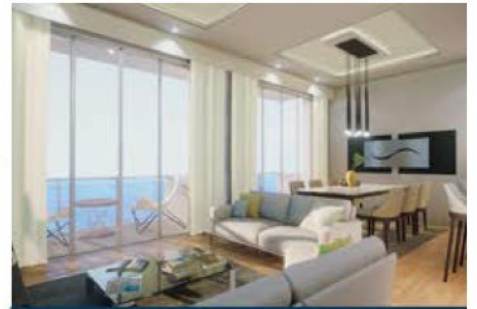
